A Message from Your Treasurer

If you have already met your 2024 pledge, thank you!

As we move through Advent and Christmas and toward the end of the church's financial year, I ask you to prayerfully consider a special Christmas financial gift for our church, for its mission, or for the benefit of the choir, altar guild, flower guild, or facility repairs. In addition to your pledge, we rely heavily on the gifts for these areas to enhance our worship and fix broken things around the building.

As of December 16th, annual 2024 pledged giving is \$41,000 below the amounts pledged for the work of our parish. While this is not totally unusual for December, I think it's important for everyone to be aware of this status with only four worship services left this year. If you have yet to meet your 2024 pledge, please make it a priority before the end of the year. This will help St Simon's meet its commitments this year while setting our 2025 beginning financial position on a level needed to continue to sustain or grow our mission "To Know Christ and Make Him Known" in our community.




