As many of you know I was released from the hospital (Ochsner's in NOLA) on Monday evening. I am so thankful for all of you and how you have been doing what God has called you to do in my absence.

I am also very grateful for having a wife who understands all this medical stuff but more so, is tireless in her support and help of me through these 32 days of hospitalization since the first of January.

I've am not yet in remission from this ulcerated colitis but definitely improving daily. We will figure out reentry in consultation with my medical team and the short-term disability folks and you will be the first to know when I will be back in action. Soon and very soon, I hope.

Your prayers and love have sustained us for sure. Thank you. Keep showing up and doing God's work!

Welcome to Lent! It will be an interesting one for me for sure. I think I will give up hospitals for Lent!



- 3. OR go to Amazon and search for Door Dash gift cards and follow the instructions.






