Update on Father David

Jennifer and Fr. David went to Ochsner for a post hospital follow-up on Tuesday. Overall, he's been doing great with the stomach issues and pain. However, he developed a new symptom that was concerning because there is a rare side effect of the medications he has been taking, that can cause these types of symptoms. It had to be ruled out quickly before he could get any more medication.

He was admitted for more tests and after a long day of MRI's, lab work and seeing numerous specialists the medication side effect was ruled out, but a Lumbar defect was discovered. David has such severe stenosis of L4-L5 that immediate surgery is indicated. Otherwise, the symptoms could get worse and possibly be irreversible.

He came through the surgery great! Now they are waiting for the doctors to let them know the plan moving forward.

They ask that we all continue to keep them in our prayers.




